

2010 CSA Arts and Crafts Fair Application

Fair Date: July 28, 2010

The Women's Association of the Congregational Summer Assembly (CSA) of Frankfort, Michigan invites you to exhibit in their annual Arts and Crafts Fair on the fourth Wednesday of each July. Rain or shine, the Arts and Crafts Fair will be held on the CSA grounds, two miles north of Frankfort, where M-22 and Crystal Lake meet.

The CSA Fair offers a wide variety of arts and crafts by both amateur and professional artisans. In addition, there are CSA-sponsored booths open for most of the day [Baked Goods, Kids' Corner, Cottage Treasures (used items), and a Food Booth featuring coffee and doughnuts in the morning and hot dogs/chips/soda for lunch].

The registration fee (see schedule below) must be sent in with your application. **Your canceled check is your acceptance notification.** If immediate notification of acceptance is desired, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope. The State of Michigan requires a valid Michigan Sales Tax License for fair exhibitors. All exhibits are shown at the exhibitor's risk, free from CSA liability.

In keeping with the philosophy of the CSA to promote the physical, intellectual, moral, and religious welfare of the constituency which it seeks to serve: **no guns or gun-like toys will be sold at the CSA Arts and Crafts Fair. Out of respect for our artisans, we ask that no mass-produced (i.e., buy/sell) items be displayed or sold.**

PLEASE REMEMBER:

1. The fair date is always the fourth Wednesday of July. On July 28th in 2010.
2. Registration and set-up time for the fair is 7 AM.
There will be absolutely no setting up the night before.
No camping is permitted on the CSA grounds.
3. Show time for the Fair is 10 AM to 4 PM. No booth breakdown prior to close.
4. Make checks payable to the: CSA Women's Association.
\$60 for booth rental (including CSA members)
\$10 for child's booth, ages 13 to 18
\$5 for child's booth, ages 12 and under
No charge for non-profit organizations (spaces limited)
5. An adult booth space is 11' x 11'. If more space is needed, you may sign up for two spaces.
6. The deadline for booth applications is July 18th.
7. In case of cancellation by booth renter, there will be no monetary refunds.
