# 2008 CSA Arts and Crafts Fair Application

The Women's Association of the Congregational Summer Assembly (CSA) of Frankfort, Michigan invites you to exhibit in their annual Arts and Crafts Fair on the fourth Wednesday of each July. Rain or shine, the Arts and Crafts Fair will be held on the CSA grounds, two miles north of Frankfort, where M-22 and Crystal Lake meet.

The CSA Fair continues to grow with a greater variety of arts and crafts by both amateur and professional artisans. In addition, there will be CSA-sponsored booths [Baked Goods, Kids' Corner, Cottage Treasures (used items), and a Food Booth featuring coffee and doughnuts in the morning and hot dogs, chips and soda for lunch] open for most of the day.

The registration fee (see schedule below) must be sent in with your application. **Your canceled check is your acceptance notification.** If immediate notification of acceptance is desired, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope. The State of Michigan requires a valid Michigan Sales Tax License for fair exhibitors. All exhibits are shown at the exhibitor's risk, free from CSA liability.

In keeping with the philosophy of the CSA to promote the physical, intellectual, moral, and religious welfare of the constituency which it seeks to serve: **no guns or gun-like toys will be sold at the CSA Arts and Crafts Fair.**

## PLEASE REMEMBER:

1. The date of the fair is always the fourth Wednesday of July.
2. Registration and set-up time for the fair is 7 AM and no earlier.  
No camping is permitted on the CSA grounds.  
There will be absolutely no setting-up the night before.
3. Show time for the Fair is 10 AM to 4 PM.
4. Make checks payable to the: CSA Women's Association.

*\$10 for child's booth, ages 13 to 18*  
*\$5 for child's booth, ages 12 and under*  
*No charge for nonprofit organizations*
5. An adult booth space is 11' x 11'. If you need more space, you may sign up for two spaces.
6. The deadline for booth applications is always July 12<sup>th</sup>.
7. In case of cancellation by booth renter, there will be no monetary refunds.
